BREWING PROCESS

This superior lager is produced using the best spring barley. The lager undergoes a slow bottom fermentation at a low temperature, followed by a cold maturation period.

TASTING NOTES

Birra Baracca Lager has a straw yellow appearance with a fresh scent of hops and a smooth flavour of yeast. With a gentle dry finish and a persistent head of foam, this Lager is an easydrinking beer that's a perfect all-rounder to suit endless occasions.

FOOD PAIRING

A very versatile Lager that is excellent as an aperitif. It pairs perfectly with fresh, light dishes such as gourmet pizza and pasta, fried seafood dishes and spicy Southeast Asian and Mexcian cuisines.

ABOUT

Birra Baracca is named after Italy's most successful fighter pilot of WW1, Francesco Baracca. A fighter ace who claimed an impressive 34 aerial victories. After his first victory, an image of a prancing horse was painted on the fuselage of his aircraft which has been used since 1923 by Ferrari upon its racing cars as a symbol of good luck. Baracca was finally shot down in 1918 on the hill of Nervesa della Battaglia, the very same hill that is home to the Cester Camillo Family, where Birra Baracca is handcrafted today.
